THIS IS A FEDERAL INSTALLATION AND TRAFFIC RULES APPLY.

- All bike riders and skateboarders must wear approved helmets.
- No riding in pick-up beds or on sides or tailgates.
- All motorcycle riders must conform to DOD traffic regulations. Proper PPE (helmet, gloves, long sleeve shirts, long sleeve pants) is mandatory.
- Speed limit is 5 mph in camping/trailer area.
- Do not talk on cell phone or text while driving in the park.
- ALL POVs must stay on authorized roads and parking areas. Off-road driving is prohibited.
- Must be a licensed driver to operate any POV. Occupants of POVs must be seated at ALL times.
- No ATV/UTV or dirt bike use on any Federal property.

RV Park, Cabins and Tent sites
Rentals & Campers: Check-in: 1500, Check-Out: No later than 1100
Quiet Hours Strictly Enforced from 2200-0700 daily

CAMPING: Campgrounds will be kept clean at all times. Trash must be placed in provided dumpsters. Tent campers are prohibited from using lanterns, stoves or anything flammable in the tents.

- Cutting of trees is prohibited. Do not break tree branches or damage park shrubbery for fire fuel.
- No metal detectors are allowed.
- Do not feed wildlife. Feeding feral cats is strictly prohibited.
- Do not dump gray/black water anywhere but in the dump station.
- Fires must be monitored at all times. Be safe. Do not put cans or glass in fires. Extinguish fires before departing the vicinity.
- Clotheslines may be used for towels and swimsuits only. Lines must be taken down at dusk for safety reasons.
- There are no pay phones; however, park offices have business phones for emergencies. The camp hosts also serve as contacts to report emergency problems after business hours.

LENGTH OF STAY: Campers may camp for a period of no longer than 90 days (30 days for designated prime sites). At that time, the camper must leave the campgrounds for a period of at least 2 weeks. They may then return for another 90 day period. Based on availability campers may cycle between Anchor Cove and Battleship Row.

PETS: Pets are allowed; however, they MUST be kept on a leash, no longer than six feet, and under immediate control of owners. Pets will not be left outside unattended. They must be walked outside of the camping area and droppings must be picked up and disposed of. Failure to do so will result in revocation of pet privileges while staying in the park. Animals are NOT allowed on beaches or in the swimming areas. Patrons with extremely noisy or vicious pets will be asked to leave. Having pets at the park is a privilege. Please be mindful of others. Pets are allowed but they cannot exceed 10 feet x 10 feet (100 square feet). Pets cannot be left unattended at any time. Pets must be removed or placed on concrete pads during mowing or weeding. Pen area must be kept clean and odor free. Sorry, pets are not allowed in the rental cabins or mobile homes or surrounding areas.

Bathroom and Laundry Facilities: Only registered guests may use the facilities. The bathrooms and laundry are available 24 hours a day, with the exception of daily cleaning. Children must be under parental supervision at all times.

PARKING: No more than two vehicles are allowed per trailer, camp, or RV site. Boats and trailers are NOT permitted to park at any campsite. Registered guests may park their boats and trailers at no additional cost in designated areas near the two main campgrounds. Each trailer must display a current Blue Angel Park sticker. The sticker must have the space number and date of departure clearly visible. Day use parking is available near the two active boat ramps. There is no overnight parking available at BAP. All unattended boats, trailers, RVs, and campers will be ticketed.

Washing of POVs/Equipment: Due to Federal and State regulations only FRESH water can be used for washing POVs or camping related equipment. **NO CHEMICALS OR BIODEGRADABLE ITEMS OF ANY TYPE CAN BE USED IN THE PARK OR ALLOWED ON THE GROUND.** Very limited mechanical/repair work can be performed in the park. Please check with the office for assistance or directions to the MWR Auto Skills Center.

VISITORS: For your safety and security, please register all guests with the Welcome Center. Sponsors are responsible for the actions of their guests at all times. Sponsored guests must pay registration fee. Authorized patrons may sponsor one guest (One RV or campsite) for a maximum of 14 days. Sponsors must be present at time of registration. Sponsors must be staying at the same Navy Getaways facility as their guest for the duration of the guests stay.

FIREARMS/FIREWORKS: No firearms or fireworks of any kind are permitted on a Federal installation.

BEACHES: There are no lifeguards on duty. Swim at your own risk. PLEASE, NO GLASS CONTAINERS ON BEACH.

External Electrical Equipment: Only electrical equipment supplied by the RV/Trailer/Camper manufacturer may be used. Prohibited items include electric air-conditioners, heaters, hot-tub heaters, washers, dryers, refrigerators, microwaves etc. This list is not all-inclusive. Small portable electric equipment such as leaf blowers, fans, or radios may be used for short durations. If in doubt ask permission before using any external electrical equipment.

After Hours Arrival & Departure Procedures

ARRIVALS:

RV Reservations: Proceed to *Battleship Row RV Park* (Full hook-up RV sites - Take a LEFT at Perdido Bay) or *Anchor Cove RV Park* (Partial hook-up RV sites - Take a RIGHT at Perdido Bay) & choose an empty site. Inform Camp Host of your site number. Check-in with our Welcome Center the following business day.

Cabin Rental: Follow directions to *Anchor Cove RV Park*. Check in with Camp Host. No arrivals after 10pm. Check-in with our Welcome Center the following business day.

Mobile Home Rental: Follow directions to *Bos'N Court Mobile Home Park*. Check-in with Trailer Host. No arrivals after 10pm. Check-in with our Welcome Center the following business day.

No Reservations: Mandatory Check-in with Camp Hosts & Check-in with our Welcome Center the following business day. Only arrivals with reservations will be taken on Sundays - no walk-ins.

DEPARTURES:

Ensure that you have a zero balance & depart your site by 1100 on your scheduled day of departure. Those departing with a balance will have their credit card on file charged.

COMMUNITY RECREATION PROGRAMS

PADDLESPORTS



Receive a customized and tailored level of kayaking or paddleboarding instruction from one of our ACA and WPA certified instructors. Lessons may be as short as a 5-minute beach session where you can learn tips about how to safely enjoy the day on the water. Or if you prefer, you may

schedule a small group or one-on-one lesson with an instructor for a longer, more in-depth level of instruction. These longer lessons may focus on any combination of topics including basic terminology, maneuvering, proper stroke technique as well as rescue and safety. Through education and promoting the enjoyment of our local environment, the goal of our Paddlesports program is to create a community of well-trained paddlers who will safely share public waterways and become responsible stewards of our natural resources.

BACKPACKING



This program is designed to give patrons and their families a better understanding of the fundamental knowledge needed to enjoy hiking, backpacking and camping safely while being introduced to a lifelong activity that promotes a healthy and active lifestyle. This program offers a 2-day Backpacking 101 Skills Course and subsequent 2-day instructor-guided Backpacking Trips throughout different areas and parks in the Southeast. During the 101 Skills Course the student will be provided with all the necessary gear as well as a full introductory to the physical and mental demands of backpacking. Leave No Trace Principles as well as wilderness safety within a controlled and safe environment. After completion of the 101 Skills Course the student will earn a personalized certificate of completion that is required for a future Backpacking Trip.

SAILING



Learn how to sail from a US Sailing certified instructor in one of BAP's sailing classes. From April through September beginner and intermediate small boat sailing classes are offered by reservation every weekend. All courses are designed with two modules - a classroom module and water skills module - to educate the sailor in best safety practices, basic sailing theory and proper sailing technique and skills. Upon the successful completion of both modules students will receive a Navy Sailing Association certification/log card which is acceptable at all MWR marina facilities worldwide. Proof of certification is required for MWR rental fleets.

PAINTBALL



Blue Angel Park's DangerZone Paintball is an MWR operated Community Recreation program servicing Military and DoD members and their families. A military or DoD ID card is required to rent equipment. Members of the public may use the field but must provide their own equipment or have a Military or DoD sponsor to rent equipment. No outside point is permitted. DangerZone Paintball is a "Woods-Ball" facility with approximately 35 acres of wooded area of play. There are 3 separate fields including a "Speed-Ball Field", a "Main Woods-Ball Field" and one "Party Field" that is available for reservation.

HISTORY OF NAAS BRONSON FIELD



In 1939 the Navy purchased 640 acres on the Perdido Bay for use as an outlying field (OLF) which was initially named Tarklin Field, to train pilots from Corry Field. In 1942, the Navy bought another 263 adjoining acres and began construction of temporary wartime base and seaplane facility. On November 18th, 1942 NAAS Bronson Field was commissioned and named for Lt. Clarence Bronson, naval aviator #15 who lost his life in a bomb explosion in 1916. After the end of World War II, NAAS Bronson Field was decommissioned in 1946 and was thereafter used as an outlying field and aircraft storage facility. The field continued to be used for pilot training until 1988 when the surrounding waterfront was transformed into the recreational area it is today. Upon exploration of the park you may discover footprints of the past. In the woods and along the waterfront, the natural environment reestablishes it's claim on the former military facility, but Bronson Field's rich history will always remain.
